THEME: Claiming our Prophetic Voices: CPE as Social Reconstruction

Peter Keese, Chair of Annual Conference Committee, wrote: "Two theological educators will dialogue about the processes of theological education, theological reflection, and engaging the social issues which provide the content for that reflective education. Our concern is not so much to hear comments on specific social or justice issues. We are looking for an emphasis on reclaiming the experiential, action-reflection method which uses the actual experiences of people as the living human documents from which we can learn about and with whom we can engage the important social issues facing us all. ... We'd like our speakers to help us think about how we develop curricula which are responsive to the social (and justice) issues.
