Actions taken at Member's Meeting in Oviedo, FL:

1. Revised Governance Manual:

Approved the **Officer of Treasurer** as an elected position and made the Treasurer an *ex officio* member of Annual Conference/Continuing Education; Budget and Investment; and Mission and Development committees. The Treasurer will present the Annual Certified Audit at each Business Meeting of the region. The Treasurer will be a voting member of the Administrative Board and may serve three consecutive two year terms plus any time served in a non-expired term in the same office. **Olen Grubbs was elected Treasurer and will begin this service on January 1, 2010.**

2. Established increases in Fees:

a. Accreditation Fees:

As of January 1, 2010, on-site reviews of **Satellite or Component Sites** will be **\$250 plus the expenses of the Reviewer** (\$150 for honorarium), and on site reviews for **Accredited Centers and Ten Year Reviews** will be **\$500** (\$150 honorarium for chairperson and \$100 for each reviewer).

As of January 1, 2011, **Annual Accredited Center Fee** will be **\$125**. **Five year review fee** will be **\$250**.

As of January 1, 2012, **Annual Accredited Center Fee** will be **\$175**.

As of January 1, 2013, **Annual Accredited Center Fee** will be **\$225**.

b. Certification Fees:

As of January 1, 2010, certification fees will be:

<i>Consultations</i>	\$150
<i>Candidacy</i>	\$200
<i>Extension of Candidacy</i>	\$200
<i>Reinstatement</i>	\$200
<i>Extension of Associate</i>	\$250

c. Student Registration Fee:

As of January 1, 2011, the **Student Registration Fee** will be **\$90** per student per unit of CPE.

4. Elected Leadership, Adopted Budget and Minutes:

As of 1 Jan 2010 the new chairpersons of standing committees are: **Wayne Maberry** (Tampa General), Accreditation; **Steve Lemons (Self Memorial)**, Annual Conference; and **Joan Murray (Children's at Eggleston)**, RANC. **Thanks for the service of Gene Robinson (Accreditation), John Galloway (Annual Conference) and Robin Booth (RANC) in 2009.**

The **adopted budget** is included in each monthly **Treasurer's Report** (click on the "News/Report" link), and the adopted budget for 2010 can be found under "News/Reports: 2010: SERACPE 2010 Adopted Budget."

As of 1 Jan 2010 the **adopted budget** for 2010 will be \$17,000 less than the 2009 budget (no income from Endowment Fund; \$10,000 decrease in income from cash reserves; small increases in accreditation and certification fees). The expense changes include an increase of \$11,800 for standing committees, \$1,600 increase in Representation to ACPE Meetings, and a decrease of \$11,566 in Regional Office expense.

Additionally, the line item for **Special Projects** was not included in the 2010 adopted budget. The amount to be awarded in 2010 will be determined by the Administrative Board based on any surplus from 2009 and the market value of the Endowment Fund as of 31 Dec 09. Recipients of grants will be determined by the Mission and Development Committee. Requests/applications should be filed with **Larry Wagoner** (Baptist in Jacksonville) by 15 December 09.

Thanks to **Phil Summerlin** for his excellent recording of the "minutes" over the years. Phil resigned as Secretary, and **Brenda Green** was elected to fill his unexpired term, effective 1 Jan 2010.

Larry has been a pioneer for CPE in Florida and a consistent mentor and colleague for students and supervisors in Florida and Southeast Georgia. This year Larry celebrates thirty years of ministry and supervision at Baptist Health (Jacksonville, FL) where he facilitated the beginning of an accredited CPE Center in 1979 and continues to serve as Director of Pastoral Care and Education.
