Find herein reflections on our work together in 2009 and some
anticipations about our work as the accrediting and certifying
agency for Clinical Pastoral Education in the Southeast USA in 2010.
Blessings, peace, grace and joy sufficient for everyone.

Greetings on this first day of 2010,
I've completed the Treasurer's Report on the Operating Budget for 2009, and there is good news.

Firstly, because we transferred \$12,000 from our cash reserves and received \$1,820 in prepaid Student Fees for 2010, we had a year-end balance of \$1,424 after having expended \$140,270. We withdrew no money from our Endowment Fund in 2009.

Secondly, this report illustrates that the Southeast Region is **invested in the primary mission** of the ACPE. We expended \$15,298 doing accreditation, \$16,744 for certification, \$5,567 on SES Projects, \$4,000 for REM Invitational, \$2,131 on peer review, \$2,584 for Mission and Development, and \$15,822 on continuing education for a total of \$62,146. The tasks of governance, history and joint projects with ACPE cost \$7,792. I can assure you that the \$67,000 expended by the regional office was supportive of all of the above activities.

We've tightened the belt in 2010, having adopted an Operating Budget of \$131,000 and limited the Special Projects funding from Endowment income to \$11,500. We're looking closely at expenses and have given ourselves a year before raising the Student Registration Fee and the Annual Accredited Center Fee. The quality of our work together and our contributions to the primary mission of the ACPE will not be diminished. Let's have a very good year in 2010! May the blessings, peace and grace of God be with us.

FEES FOR 2010

Accreditation Fees:

Annual Accredited Center Fee	\$75
Five Year Accreditation Review	\$250
Site Review for Accreditation	\$500
Site Review for Ten Year Review	\$500

Annual Accredited Center Fee **will increase** \$50 each year for the next three years. Beginning in 2011 the fee will be \$125; in 2012, \$175; and in 2013, \$225. Invoices are mailed in early January.

Certification Fees:

Consultations	\$150
Candidacy	\$200
Extension of Candidacy	\$200
Reinstatement	\$200
Extension of Associate	\$250

Student Registration Fee: (per student, per unit) \$70 [increase in 2011 to \$90]

Ordinarily, there are no invoices from the regional office for certification and student registration fees. Those invoices are generated by the ACPE Supervisor within the accredited center, and payments are made directly to the regional office from the CPE Center's fiscal service department. Most centers utilize the "Student Registration Form" that can be emailed from the regional office upon request.
