ACCREDITATION REPORT TO SOUTHEAST REGION

You’ve likely seen the latest ACPE News that lists the actions taken by the Accreditation Commission at its meeting in November. Though it is “old news” I want to underline the achievement of two of our centers that were granted *Continued Accreditation Membership* following their Ten Year Review:

The Institute for Chaplaincy & Clinical Pastoral Education—Care and Counseling Center of Georgia, Decatur, GA with *commendation for 305.1*.

The Training and Counseling Center at St. Luke’s (TACC), Atlanta, GA with *commendation for 302.1, 302.2, 309.1, 309.4*.

The reviewers recommended these commendations and the commission celebrated the opportunity to note excellence. Join me in noting and celebrating these achievements of our colleagues.

We had one center that received accreditation as a System and moved from *Candidacy* to *Accredited System*. Congratulations to Supervisor Connie Bonner and the staff at The Partnership for CPE. The system has two component sites: Morton Plant Health Care and Suncoast Hospice, Clearwater, FL.

We had four centers that received continuing accreditation for their programs that were not listed in the November report in the ACPE News. That oversight was my mistake, and I offer apologies to the centers and supervisors for any anxiety this may have caused them. Those centers receiving *Continued Accredited Membership* were: Emory Center for Pastoral Services, Self Regional Medical Center, North Atlanta CPE Center, and Chattanooga Association for CPE.

You’ve no doubt noted a number of notations made by the Accreditation Commission. Many of those were related to 300.1 and had to do with late unit reporting. A few were from centers being late in submitting Annual Center Reports.

As you prepare your Annual Report for 2010, remember that you are to report changes made in your policies. It is enough to note which policies you updated. You may send the entire updated policy, but it is enough to indicate the changes made to your policy.

Also, I’m fine with receiving scanned electronic copies of your reports by the January 15 deadline, but I request that you make sure they have been signed by the primary supervisor and the Chairperson of your PAG. Respectfully submitted, Wayne Maberry.
