### ***Report from Accreditation Committee by Wayne Maberry***

Ten Year Reviews (cf. Accreditation Manual, pages 41-42): NCH Healthcare System, Palmetto Health, The Ingalls Center of Pastoral Ministries

Candidacy to Accredited Member (cf. Accreditation Manual, p. 24): Northeast Georgia Medical Center

Candidacy and ten year reviews need to take place before the middle of November.

Congratulations to those making requests and thanks to those making the decisions and taking the actions.

### ***Report from the Administration Board***

We noted the death of ACPE Supervisor Roland Rainwater, gave thanks for his contributions to CPE, and asked for the comfort of God for those who grieve his loss.

Three actions were taken by the Administrative Board:

1. At the request of Rhonda Daniels to be relieved as the chair of RANC, the AB asked **Keith Munford** to serve as Chair of RANC for 2013. (He has agreed to do so.)
2. Because the Invitational for Supervisors of SES Programs was so successful, and at the request of the Certification Committee, the AB endorsed and will support a similar meeting at Epworth by the Sea on January 12-14, 2014, and the AB requested the Budget and Investment Committee to include **\$15,000 in the 2014 Budget**, the income to be taken from the cash reserves of the SERegion.
3. The President of ACPE has appointed a Search Committee for the next ACPE Executive Director. The AB of the SERACPE **“requests our representatives to the ACPE Bd of Reps to inform that body that the SERegion prefers that the next ED would be theologically educated and be a certified ACPE Supervisor.**

### *Summary of the Treasurer’s Report*

The \$20,005 costs of the SES Invitational at Epworth was offset enough by registration fees (\$6,690) so that we completed a most productive and informative event for fifty ACPE Supervisors within the budgeted \$15,000 taken from our cash reserves according to an action by the members last fall.

We’ve also completed a Leadership Meeting at Hickory Knob in March; and with all bills paid, we’ve expended a bit over \$17,000.

Even though the March Treasurer’s Report shows a deficit of \$6,094, we are very solvent. With income from spring and summer units, we will have enough reserve funds to cover our fall meeting in Greenville, SC.

You have been very good stewards of what we have received, and we have done the primary businesses of accreditation and certification.

A detailed line item accounting of the operating budget can be found on our website, *seracpe.org*, in each monthly Treasurer’s Report.

**Reminder: In 2013, Annual Accredited Center Fee is \$175. Five Year Accreditation Review is \$250. Site Reviews are \$500. Student Unit Registration Fee is \$90 per student per unit.**

Thanks to be to God and to Jerry Williamson for her knowledge, expertise and sacrificial service in providing the necessary documentations to keep the ACPE as an accrediting agency on the Federal Registry. May our accrediting agency status be continued!

These are days of major decisions in a most defining transition for the ACPE. Please, do what you can to discern and implement the best way forward for the future of the ACPE!
